

- ➤ ICR: The Age of the Earth's Atmosphere Estimated by its Helium Content
 - Larry Vardiman, Ph.D. If the earth is billions of years old, the radioactive production of helium in the earth's crust should have added a large quantity of helium to its atmosphere.
 - Current diffusion models all indicate that helium escapes to space from the atmosphere at a rate much less than its production rate.
 - The low concentration of helium actually measured would suggest that the earth's atmosphere must be quite young. Technical. (7 pages)
