 - Dr. Bock (Ph.D., Aberdeen) is research professor of New Testament studies and professor of spiritual development and culture at Dallas Theological Seminary in Dallas, Texas.
 - He has written volumes on Luke in the Baker Exegetical Commentary on the New Testament and is a past president of the Evangelical Theological Society.
 - This is an online edition of the *IVP New Testament Commentary* on Luke.

- Bruce Goettsche: <u>Sermons on Luke</u>
 - Bruce Goettsche began his ministry at Union Church in La Harpe, Illinois, in February of 1982.
 - He is a graduate of Trinity University in Deerfield, Illinois, where he received his B.A. in Biblical Studies; Northern Baptist Theological Seminary, where he earned both a Master of Arts in Christian Education, and a Master of Divinity degree.
 - The author of 19 books, Bruce believes strongly in the systematic exposition of God's Word.
- > Dr. Alexander MacLaren: <u>Expositions of Holy Scripture: Luke</u>
 - Called the "prince of expositors," Alexander MacLaren was a renowned preacher of the 19th and 20th century.

- *Expositions of Holy Scripture* brings together many of the sermons over his fifty years in ministry. Although it discusses many different books and passages of the Bible, *Expositions of Holy Scripture* isn't a commentary in the fullest sense for example, MacLaren doesn't comment on every verse. Rather, this volume contains MacLaren's powerful sermons, arranged by the text of the sermons.
- Broadly evangelical in nature, MacLaren's sermons are not historical—rarely referring to the current events of his day—allowing them to retain their interest and power since he first gave them.
- *Expositions of Holy Scriptures* is thus highly practical and lively. It makes a wonderful companion to more textually oriented commentaries. To read *Expositions of Holy Scripture* is to be in the presence of one of the greatest preachers of the last few centuries. Superb!
- > Dr. David Malick: <u>An Argument of the Gospel of Luke</u>
 - Very well presented. (107 pages)
- > Dr. Alfred Plummer: <u>The Gospel According to St. Luke</u>
 - This is a PDF file of the entire commentary which is a volume in the International Critical Commentary series, published in 1913 by T.&T. Clarke, Edinburgh.
- Ron M. Ritchie: Jesus: Savior of the Lost
 - A series of 69 sermons on the Gospel of Luke preached at Peninsula Bible Church in Palo Alto, California where Ron ministered for 27 years.
- > J.C. Ryle: <u>Expository Thoughts on the Gospel of Luke</u>
 - John Charles Ryle (1816-1900) was an English evangelical Anglican bishop. He was the first Anglican bishop of Liverpool and was pastor of Christ Church, Oxford, and Rector of Helmingham, Suffolk.
