### CHRIST'S FINAL WORDS, SPOKEN FROM THE CROSS

1. And Jesus said, **“Father, forgive them, for they know not what they do.”**  
~ LUKE 23:34 (ESV)
2. And He said to him, **“Truly I say to you, today you will be with Me in Paradise.”** ~ LUKE 23:43 (NASB)
3. When Jesus saw his mother there, and the disciple whom he loved standing nearby, he said to her, **“Woman, here is your son,”** and to the disciple [John], **“Here is your mother.”** From that time on, this disciple took her into his home.  
~ JOHN 19:26-27 (NIV)
4. About three in the afternoon Jesus cried out in a loud voice, **“Eli, Eli, lema sabachthani?”** (which means, “My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?”). ~ MATTHEW 27:46 (NIV) (See Psalm 22:1)
5. Jesus knew that his mission was now finished, and to fulfill Scripture he said, **“I am thirsty.”** ~ JOHN 19:28 (NLT) (See Psalm 69:21)
6. When Jesus had tasted it, he said, **“It is finished!”** Then he bowed his head and gave up his spirit. ~ JOHN 19:30 (NLT)
7. Jesus called out with a loud voice, **“Father, into your hands I commit my spirit.”** When he had said this, he breathed his last. ~ LUKE 23:46 (NIV) (See Psalm 31:5.)
